Amendments in the Guidelines for empanelling officers for appointment as

Director General of Police (Head of Police Force)

The existing provisions in para 2(a) and Annexure-1 of the Guidelines shall be substituted namely:

## Zone of Consideration [indicated in para 2(a)]

The normal zone of consideration shall consist of officers who are holding the post of Director General of Police (DGP) in the State cadre in Level-16 of the Pay matrix as on date of occurrence of vacancy.

Indicative Areas for Assessing Range of Experience of an IPS Officer relevant for Heading the Police Force (Indicated in Annexure-1)

The range of experience of an officer will be considered adequate if he has a minimum of 10 years experience as on date of occurrence of vacancy in one or more of the following areas:
