EQ (A):(i) A recognized MBBS degree qualification included in the First Schedule or Second Schedule or Part II of the Third Schedule (other than licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Holders of Educational qualifications included in Part II of the Third Schedule should also fulfill the conditions specified in sub-section (3) of section 13 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

(ii) Post-Graduate Degree in the concerned specialty as mentioned in section A in Schedule VI i.e. M.D.(Forensic Medicine).

EXPERIENCE EQ(B):- Three years' experience in the concerned Specialty after obtaining the first Post Graduate degree.
